


people and property: Always fly your done in a considerate manner!

Top 5 rules:

- The drone should always be kept within your sight and operated in a mindful and considerate manner. Never fly near accident sites.
- Never fly closer than 5 km from airports unless you have explicit clearance to do so.
- Never fly higher than 120 meters off the ground.
- Never fly over festivals, military sites or sporting events. Keep a distance of 150 meters.
- Be considerate of others privacy. Take note of the rules concerning photos and films of other people.
