Dear Mrs. or Mr.,

My name is Ivana Corba and I am writing you on behalf of the Ark of Noah museum ship.

The Ark of Noah is an educational project which presents the Bible stories from the cultural point of view. The Ark has been sailing around Europe for five years. For the first time it came to Norway in summer 2015. Right now the ship is in Stavanger and in December 2015 the Ark will anchor in the harbor of Bergen. It will stay in Bergen for three whole months till February 2016. On board we have a great educational learning program for kids of all age categories. We would like to see many schools coming on board of the Ark and experience a large piece of history.

“The Ark of Noah” is the first floating history Bible museum in Europe and a splendid art exhibition. The Ark was built in the Netherlands. It is an educational project which presents the Bible stories from the cultural point of view. On the Ark you can find a story of Noah, Adam & Eve, Cain & Abel, David and Goliath and many more. These Bible stories are a part of the long history of Europe and as well a part of our culture. In addition, the museum brings many educational lessons that are significant for our society. When entering the museum, each pupil gets a map of the Ark and a quiz which helps them to go through the whole exhibitions and which is created by means that teaches them about human history and gives a lot of facts from the Bible and from history overall. Noah’s Ark is a free place for everyone regardless of a background or a world-view. The Ark is 70 meters long, 13 meters high, 10 meters wide and 2000 square meters stretching on 4 floors.
